## Brush Management Season Aug 16<sup>th</sup> to Feb 28<sup>th</sup>

The Goats are currently at the bottom of Kristen Glen next to High Rose trail. They will be moving into their next paddock located behind Kristen View Ct. and Old Stonefield Dog Park. They will continue to work through the community in the order that follows the Fire Marshal's recommendation. Beginning at Cerro Del Sur through Artesian Ridge then onto Increments 1-4. They will finish off at the Estates as they do every season.

As a reminder, please keep well back from the goat enclosures and please do not feed the animals including the dogs. Be aware that the shepherd dogs have been trained to protect the goats from coyotes etc. Please keep pets/dogs away from the goat the enclosures as the shepherd dogs are very protective of the goats.

# January 2024 Landscape Newsletter

Happy New Year. As we leave behind 2023 and head into a new year, horticulture practices will be as follows. Please see the list below of maintenance items proceeding this month.

- \*Monitor plant material for insects and disease.
- \*Leaf debris pick up.
- \*Continue standard maintenance practices in trimming
- \*Focus on tree staking in preparation for winter rains
- \*Continue to check all Bio Swells and V-ditches through rain events

Leaf Debris:

Sycamores and Evergreen Elms continue to drop leaves. The crews will continue to blow and remove debris from sidewalks and planters in their rotation area.



Frost warning:

Although many plants throughout the community are very resilient, frost and cold weather can cause damage. Frost can be fatal to some plants that experience several frosts without recovery time in between harsh weather occurrences. Damage from frost can have the appearance that a plant is dying. The best way to treat a frost-damaged plant is to leave the damaged foliage on the top until there is consistent warmer weather. This damaged material will act as a blanket for the non-damaged undergrowth until the threat of frost has passed.



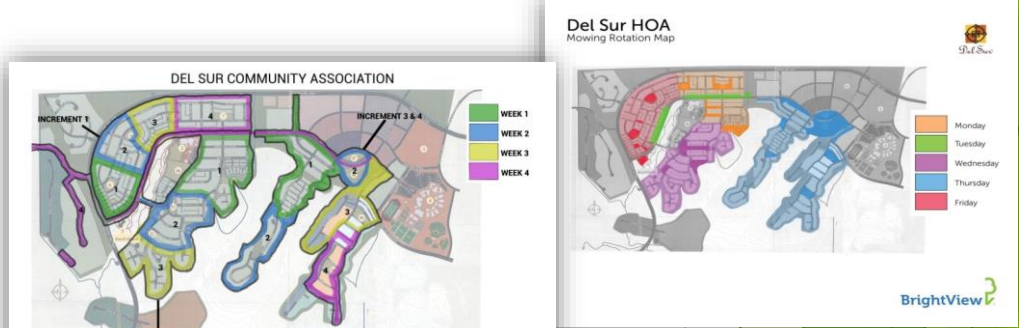
Mowing

Mowing under wet conditions can damage turf significantly. The weight of the machines can cause ruts and rip the roots of the turf. Mowing will occur during the wet months when conditions are safe to do so.

## Dogs Off Leash

It has come to our attention that residents are having their dogs running around the community parks without a leash. As a reminder, we have 4 dog parks in Del Sur where that is allowed. 3 along Paseo Del Sur (1 by the SDG&E easement and 2 between Potomac Ridge and Babcock St.) and the dog park behind Old Stonefield Park. Please note that having your dogs off leashes anywhere within the community excluding these dog parks and your own home is not only a breach of your Community Guidelines but also local ordinances. ### Please adhere to these rules:

- always pick up after your pet;
- do not bring a puppy to the dog park until all required vaccinations are complete;
- be sure that your dog's required vaccinations are up to date for the health of all dogs on site; and
- be sure that your dog is wearing a current license from the San Diego Humane Society.

## Old Stonefield Park – Swings (update!)

As you may have been aware, the swings in the play area at Old Stonefield Park have been out of order and have had caution tape attached for a while now. The swings have been replaced! The new swing set has been installed as of the week of November 13th. Thank you for your continued patience on this project. Enjoy!

## Trailers/RVs/Boats

There has been an increase in trailers and RVs parked within the community. We just want to remind everyone that RVs, Boats, and/or Trailers cannot be parked on any of the streets in Del Sur for longer than 8 hours.

### PARKING AND VEHICULAR GUIDELINES

- **Item 4 States:** An owner may park any standard passenger vehicle (including vans and similar vehicles up to and including one [1] ton when used for everyday transportation) in any portion of the Property subject to restrictions. The vehicle shall not extend into a sidewalk or beyond the curb line or impede access over any street.
- **Item 5 States:** The following vehicles are prohibited vehicles: (i) recreational vehicles (including motor homes, travel trailers, camper vans and watercraft), (ii) large commercial-type vehicles (including pick-up trucks having a payload capacity in excess of one ton, stake-bed trucks, tank trucks, dump trucks, step vans, concrete trucks, common commercial vehicles and limousines), (iii) vehicles designed to accommodate more than ten (10) people, (iv) vehicles having more than two (2) axles, (v) trailers, inoperable vehicles or parts of vehicles, (vi) aircraft, (vii) other similar vehicles, (viii) any vehicle or vehicular equipment deemed a nuisance by the Board, or (ix) vehicles in violation of an ordinance of the City of San Diego.

Prohibited vehicles may not be parked, stored or kept on any public or private street in, adjacent to or visible from the Property or on any other Community Association property parking area unless (a) they are owned and used by the Community Association or a Neighborhood Corporation in connection with management or maintenance of a part of the Covered Property, (b) they are parked for brief periods not to exceed eight (8) hours for loading and unloading purposes only, as may be defined in the Community Guidelines, (c) they are parked in an owner's fully enclosed garage with the door closed. If a vehicle qualifies as both an authorized vehicle and a prohibited vehicle, then the vehicle is presumed to be a prohibited vehicle, unless the Board expressly classifies the vehicle as an authorized vehicle in writing.

There are many things' homeowners/residents can do to help protect our neighbor's property and your home. Keep a lookout for more crime prevention tips in your future Del Sur News bulletins. Officer Briggs would like to hear from neighborhood reps or residents that would like to form a neighborhood watch group in their community.

1. Report suspicious activity to the San Diego Police Department immediately using the contact info above.
2. Do not leave valuables in cars, always double check the doors are locked before entering the house.
3. Have a neighbor pick up your delivered packages so they are not left in full view.
4. Make sure you are aware of your surroundings. Double-checking things are put away and locked up.
5. Install timers that turn on lights in different windows at different times.
6. Install deadbolts to all doors that enable entry, including upstairs where entry can be gained.
7. Install/ update alarm system and set it anytime you are away from home.
8. Install glass break sensors on windows and doors.
9. Install motion sensors on all floors and windows.
10. Stop mail delivery and package deliveries while on vacation.
11. Install security cameras outside your home.
12. Notify the local police department or a trusted neighbor when you are going to be away.
13. Use outdoor lighting. Light up dark spot in your yard. For pennies per night, it adds security to your home and the surrounding area. Please submit your variance request through the HOA.
14. Do not let any service representative into your home without proper identification.
15. Contact Officer Briggs to organize a security inspection of your property and home. This service will help to provide crime prevention initiatives/solutions directly related and relevant to your own home.

## E-Bikes

Motorists, please keep an eye out for riders. If your child has an E-Bike or standard bicycle, please make sure your child/children are being safe, taking care around parked vehicles and using bicycle lanes. Be safe be seen at night. For their safety, turn this into a teaching moment for them. Speak to them about how dangerous it can be to have multiple riders and what could happen if one of their friends is injured while they are driving. Please also talk to them about the dangers of speeding through the community, through intersections, around the town center, including up through the Ranch House area. Thanks in advance parents for your assistance, as we look out together for our precious kids of Del Sur.
